Essential Documents

- ☐ Passport (valid for 6+ months beyond travel dates)
- ☐ Cruise booking confirmation & boarding passes
- ☐ Travel insurance documents
- ☐ COVID-19 vaccination record (if applicable)
- ☐ Emergency contact list
- ☐ Any necessary visas or ESTA (for US entry)



Toiletries and Health Items

- ☐ Basic toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- ☐ High-SPF sunscreen
- ☐ Insect repellent
- ☐ Lip balm with SPF
- ☐ Seasickness remedies (wristbands, tablets, ginger chews)
- ☐ Personal medications in their original containers
- ☐ First aid kit (plasters, antiseptic, painkillers)



Gear and Essentials

- ☐ Daypack or small rucksack
- ☐ Refillable water bottle
- ☐ Camera or smartphone
- ☐ Extra memory cards
- ☐ Charging cables
- ☐ Travel adaptor – US-style plug sockets



Useful Extras to Consider

- ☐ Notebook or journal
- ☐ Zip-lock bags – for organising or storing wet/dirty items
- ☐ Laundry bag and detergent –if the ship offers self-service laundry
- ☐ Small umbrella or compact rain poncho
- ☐ Dry bags – protect electronics on wet excursions
- ☐ Collapsible walking stick – for extra support on rugged terrain



Clothing

Base Layers:

- ☐ Thermal underwear (tops and bottoms)
- ☐ Moisture-wicking t-shirts or long-sleeve shirts

Mid Layers:

- ☐ Fleece or wool jumpers
- ☐ Lightweight insulated jackets

Outer Layers:

- ☐ Waterproof and windproof jacket
- ☐ Waterproof trousers for shore excursions

Casual Clothing:

- ☐ Comfortable trousers or jeans
- ☐ T-shirts and casual tops
- ☐ Cardigans or light jumpers for onboard comfort

Footwear:

- ☐ Waterproof walking shoes or hiking boots
- ☐ Comfortable shoes for onboard use
- ☐ Flip-flops or sandals (for the pool or spa areas)

Accessories:

- ☐ Wool hat or beanie
- ☐ Waterproof gloves
- ☐ Scarf or neck gaiter
- ☐ Sunglasses with UV protection
- ☐ Swimwear (yes, for hot tubs and spa facilities)
